Welcome back everyone! It's been nearly six months since we last welcomed students into our school. We are very excited to finally see everyone once again! Our first day of school will be Tuesday, 9/1/2020.

With the return to school this year, we have some new information we feel is extremely important to get to our families. The following is a short list of some of the COVID-19 related safety protocols we've implemented for the 2020-21 school year. These are designed to keep everyone as safe as possible. Everyone is expected to follow these guidelines if they are attending school for face-to-face instruction:

- Students and staff are required to wear masks.
  - Lockers use will be limited but allowed as we are requiring masks to be worn.
- Students and staff will be washing their hands in accordance with CDC guidelines.
- Students will use EPA approved hand sanitizer provided by the school when entering areas in the school.
- High contact areas of the school will be disinfected every 3 hours. Buses will be disinfected after each run.
- Students from the same family will sit with each other when riding the bus. Masks will be worn the entire time a student is on the bus.
- When arriving at school students will go immediately to their classrooms. Students will not be permitted to congregate in the hallways.
- Breakfast will be served in the classrooms.
- Lunch will be served in the classrooms. When staff availability and weather permit, recess will be held outside on the soccer field. Students will be kept in groups by classroom.
- Enclosed with this letter is a screening agreement. Please read it over carefully and return it to school on September 1st to your child's teacher.

Please review these with your child/children so they are prepared to follow the new safety protocols. It is imperative that we all work together to keep our students, staff, and community as safe as possible. We appreciate your cooperation and support during these challenging times.
