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### **NTW/HIS 2019-2020 Semester Grading Policy Student Guide for Standard Courses**

The following is a guide for determining how each class will be graded:

1. Take your 3rd marking period grade designated in Powerschool. This is the lowest grade you can earn provided you engage in the course as directed by your teacher.
2. If you stay involved in your course until the end of the regularly scheduled school year (or May 15th for Seniors), you will be given the choice of receiving a) Your 3rd marking period grade as your semester grade b) An improved reflection of your 3rd marking period grade (for example, a teacher may choose to raise a "C" to a "B" if work completed during the closure was exemplary). c) A "CR" to indicate credit awarded for the course without an impact on your overall G.P.A.
3. If you failed your 3rd marking period, you will be given the opportunity to demonstrate learning and earn a "CR." Your teacher will give you additional work and determine whether this has been adequately demonstrated at the end of the semester. If it has not, the teacher may issue an "I," and you will be given the opportunity to complete this course via Summer School or the following semester.
4. Students who completely disengage can be given an "I" as a semester grade. They will be given the opportunity to complete the course via Summer School or the following semester without penalty.
5. Teachers have the discretion to waive assignments due to hardships their students are experiencing or limitations on the availability of learning materials or technology. Please reach out to your teachers if you are having issues. Our first priority is your safety and well being during this time, and we understand the need for flexibility.
