Michigan Governor Gretchen Whitmer announced last night, March 12th, that she had issued a state-wide closure for all K-12 school buildings, releasing in her statement that "This is a necessary step to protect our kids, our families, and our overall public health."

As of today, Nah Tah Wahsh Public School Academy **will be closed for all students in grades RK-12 and teachers starting Monday, March 16th, through Sunday, April 5th.**

We are planning to reopen for classes and students on Monday, April 6th.

In the meantime, the following actions are being developed:

- Essential staff will be working to disinfect all appropriate rooms and facilities;
- Kitchen staff will continue to prepare bag lunches for students throughout the closure. Starting Monday, March 16th bag lunches will be available for pick up at 11:30. More details to come - please watch our facebook page for updates.

We ask that you PLEASE honor the following requests:

- The public is asked to stay off campus during this time;
- All athletic teams, activities, and student programs are suspended until further notice.

We are continuing to monitor incoming guidance from state and tribal government, as well as health officials, to make informed decisions and evaluate our actions. Your continued assistance and understanding is appreciated during these challenging times.
